What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information to provide services in the form of after school clubs:

- Names and contact details
- Date of birth / year group
- Payment details (including card or bank information for transfers and direct debits)
- Health information (including dietary requirements, medication requirements, allergies and health conditions)

We collect or use the following information for the operation of customer accounts and guarantees:

- Names and contact details
- Payment details (including card or bank information for transfers and direct debits)

Lawful bases

Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information to provide services and goods are:

- Consent
- Contract
- Vital interests
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Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information for the operation of customer accounts and guarantees are:

- Consent
- Contract

Where we get personal information from

- People directly, namely parents, carers and guardians of children

How long we keep information

- All records are kept for the period of time a child is signed onto an after school club
- Should a child withdraw from a club part way through a course, all records relating to the child will be deleted



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Who we share information with

Others we share personal information with

- Sporty Stars staff, relative to the club the child is attending
- Emergency services (where necessary)

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

- Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data.
- Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal data you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.
- Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances.
- Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.
- Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.
- Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.
- Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent.
- You don't usually need to pay a fee to exercise your rights. If you make a request, we have one calendar month to respond to you.
- To make a data protection rights request, please contact us using the contact details at the top of this privacy notice.

How to complain

If you have any concerns about our use of your personal data, you can make a complaint to us using the contact details at the top of this privacy notice.

If you remain unhappy with how we've used your data after raising a complaint with us, you can also complain to the ICO.
